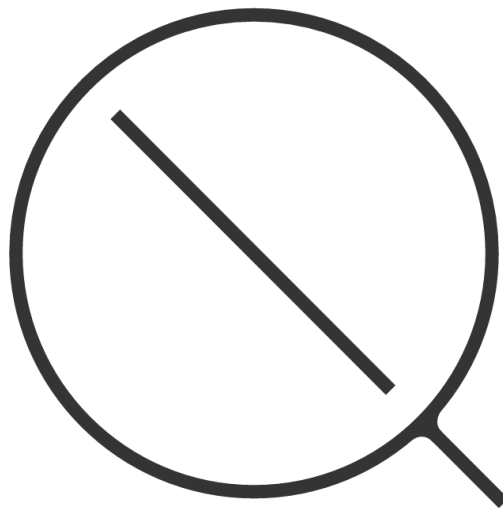

PRICES AND DISCOUNTS

Great Added Value for 2019-2020!

VALUE! A copy of the year-end recital is complimentary with enrollment at QDA.

BIG SAVINGS FOR EVERYONE! All pictures for classes, groups, trios, duos, and solos are complimentary with enrollment. See picture week for more details.

Family Discount!

Family discount is 10% off the second student's tuition from the same household. Each additional student receives 5% off tuition. Offer applies to the student(s) taking the lesser number of classes. See office for details.

What Do I Have to Pay for at the Time of Registration?

There are 2 things you pay for when registering to secure your spot.

1. \$30.00 registration fee per family each year.
2. \$20.00 costume deposit for every class that your student registers for.

After I Register, What Other Fees Do I Have to Pay?

There are 2 more items left to pay for that you can choose to pay monthly on the 1st of every month or you can opt to pay up front (1 annual payment) at the time of registration. See MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN or FULL PAYMENT PLAN for more details.

Late Fee & NSF Fee

Late fees will be charged at a rate of \$1.00 per day for all past due payments until the payment has been collected.

If a student(s) has 2 monthly past due payments outstanding at the same time, the student's caregiver will be informed that they are not eligible to attend class until all past due payments and late fees have been collected.

Monthly payment privileges will be revoked if 3 past due payments occur within a dance season (September 1 to June 1). The monthly payment option will be reinstated after a full dance season has been complete with no late payments.

Competitive Classes – If a student(s) has 2 monthly past due payments outstanding at the same time, the student's caregiver will be informed that their student(s) is no longer eligible to participate on the Quantum Elite Team. However, caregivers will still be responsible for covering the entire fees associated with your child's competitive pieces that they have enrolled in and any late fees associated with these outstanding balances.

MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

Methods of Payment: MasterCard or Visa

Registration Fee: \$30.00 non-refundable registration fee is due per family at time of registration.

Due Date: Automatic withdrawal will be taken from a Credit Card on the 1st of every month for ten months (September – June). An administration fee of \$1.85 per family is due each month for this monthly service.

Costume Fees: A \$20.00 non-refundable costume deposit per class is due at time of registration. From September 1st, 2019 until June 1st, 2020 a costume fee per class will automatically be withdrawn at the same time as your monthly payment. See monthly costume fees below.

EVENTS

Costume Sizing: Please see front desk staff during office hours in October to get sized for your costume. Deadline to get sized is November 1st, 2019. If you do not get sized before then, a size will be selected for you.

Halloween Week: From October 24th to October 30th, 2019 students may participate in Halloween Week at Quantum by dressing up in their favorite costume. There are no classes on Halloween.

Spirit Week: Kick the winter blues with Spirit Week at *Quantum Dance Academy*. Dress up in a fun theme each day of the week. Dress code not in effect during this week. Takes place from January 20th – 25th, 2020.

Monday – PJ Day: Just roll out of bed and you're set!

Tuesday – Jersey Day: Pick your favorite teams jersey and wear it to dance.

Wednesday – Back to the Future 80's theme: Neon colors, parachute pants and shoulder pads.

Thursday – Crazy Hair Day: Break out the dyes, gels, blow dryers and whatever else to get creative!

Friday/Saturday – Superhero & Princess Day: Pull out the tiaras and capes for this one.

Picture Week! (NO EXTRA FEES): Pictures take place during regular class time. Students will have their pictures taken with their recital costume. Hair and make-up instructions will be sent to parents before picture day. Pictures take place from April [REDACTED], 2020 in Ile des Chenes, April [REDACTED], 2020 in Lorette, and May [REDACTED] in St. Norbert. Competition pieces that are done outside of class time will be scheduled and students will be notified of the dates and time. Pictures are complimentary, and there are no fees for this event.

Family Viewing Week: Parents are not permitted in the studio during class time. Parents may view regular scheduled classes in the studio during Family Viewing Week December 2nd, 2019 to December 7th, 2019.

Lorette & Ile des Chenes Recital Tickets: Recital Tickets will go on sale March 2nd, 2020. More details to come.

St. Norbert Recital Tickets: Recital Tickets will go on sale March 9th, 2020. More details to come.

St. Norbert Recital Date: [REDACTED] Students will participate in one full costume recital. The dress rehearsal will be held the same day as the recital. The dress rehearsal will start at [REDACTED], with the recital in the evening. Dress rehearsal is not mandatory, but strongly recommended. One caregiver may accompany their child to the dress rehearsal. Parents and family members will need to purchase tickets to view the show. The recital is expected to end at approximately [REDACTED].

Lorette & Ile des Chenes Recital Date: [REDACTED] Students will participate in one full costume recital. The dress rehearsal will be held the same day as the recital. The dress rehearsal will start at [REDACTED], with the recital in the evening. Dress rehearsal is not mandatory, but strongly recommended. One caregiver may accompany their child to the dress rehearsal. Parents and family members will need to purchase tickets to view the show. The recital is expected to end at approximately [REDACTED].

POLICIES

Absences and Punctuality: Students are encouraged to arrive at least five minutes early in order to be prepared for class. If students are unable to attend a class, parents are expected to notify *Quantum Dance Academy* in advance by email to info@quantumdance.ca. If absences begin to accumulate, at the sole discretion of a Director students will be withdrawn from recital and competition events. All costume, choreography, entry, and tuition fees are still applicable and will be collected even if a student is unable to perform due to poor attendance in class.

Behaviour: Students are expected to demonstrate courteous, polite and respectful behaviour at all times towards teachers, all students in the class, and to fellow dancers at events. Bullying and harassment will not be tolerated by students or parents.

Class Cancellations: Throughout the year, classes may be cancelled due to weather advisory warnings issued by Environment Canada. Some students and most teachers travel from out of town, and we need to ensure safe travel is available to and from the studios. In the event of poor weather or driving conditions, class cancellations will be emailed, and announced on social media by 2:00pm of that day. Refunds will not be issued for cancelled classes since tuition is set at a rate, which allows for several cancellations throughout the year. The 2018-19 dance season had 1 day of cancellation due to the weather.

Costumes: Each class will require a costume for the year-end recital. A non-refundable deposit of \$20.00 per costume is due at time of registration. If a student is unable to participate in the recital due to unforeseen illness, injury, withdrawal from classes, or other commitments, etc., the costume must still be paid for. Any alterations to costumes are at the expense of the student. Late fees will be applied for costume payments not received on time.

Dress Code: Please follow the Dress Code for all classes. Jewelry is not to be worn in class. *Quantum Dance Academy* does not assume liability for lost or stolen items. Please label belongings and leave valuables at home.

Food and Drink: Food and drinks are not permitted in the studio. *Quantum Dance Academy* is a peanut-free facility. Water bottles are permitted in the studio.

News: Newsletters and important information will be emailed to parents and caregivers. All important dates are always available to view in our dance package.

Programs: Instructors will determine the appropriate level in which students are placed. Several factors are taken into consideration when making this decision such as age, attitude, maturity, natural ability, and previous experience. The schedule for classes is subject to change depending on enrollment. In the event a class is cancelled, a Director will place students into a similar level.

Publicity Release: Students and parents give consent to *Quantum Dance Academy* to publish photographs and videos for advertising, media and publicity purposes.

Volunteers: Volunteers are required for the year-end recital. Sign-up sheets will be posted a month prior to the recital. Please see office staff during office hours to sign-up.

Refunds: Registration fee is non-refundable. Costume deposit is non-refundable. No refunds will be issued once a monthly payment has been processed. After November 1st, 2019, refunds of any type (monthly or full) will not be issued.

- Full Payments: A refund will be issued for tuition (for classes students have not participated in) from the date a parent provides written notification of withdrawal to a Director of *Quantum Dance Academy*. Confirmation of withdrawal from a Director is required. There is a \$30.00 administrative cancellation fee that will be deducted from the refund. Costume payments will be refunded with exception of the \$20.00 non-refundable deposit per class. After November 1st, 2019 no refunds will be issued for any reason.
- Monthly Payments: A parent must provide written notification of withdrawal to a Director of *Quantum Dance Academy*. Confirmation of withdrawal from a Director is required. You will no longer be charged for monthly tuition fees. There are no refunds once a monthly payment is processed. After November 1st, 2019 no refunds will be issued, and your monthly payments (tuition and costume fees) will continue to be charged until the last payment on June 1st, 2020.

CLASS DESCRIPTION

Creative Movement: Introduces students to the basics of creative movement while developing coordination, rhythm, flexibility, and a joy for dance.

Mini Hip Hop & Pre Hip Hop: Introduces students to the basics of Hip Hop technique while developing coordination, rhythm, flexibility, and a joy for dance.

Pre Dance: A combo class that introduces the fundamentals of Ballet, Jazz, Acro and Tap.

Acro: A style of dance that combines classical dance technique with precision acrobatic elements.

Ballet: A classical dance form demanding poise, precision, and technique. Ballet is the foundation of all dance forms.

Broadway/Musical Theatre: A class that incorporates songs, spoken dialogue, acting and dance to famous Broadway musicals.

Contemporary/Lyrical: A form of dance that incorporates elements of Ballet and Jazz in order to communicate a story or emotion. It also incorporates new and innovative movement through ground breaking choreography.

Hip Hop: A high energy class that uses cool and funky moves to trendy Hip Hop music. It is a fun, creative and very expressive refined form of street dance seen in the entertainment industry.

Jazz: A class that combines classical Ballet technique and modern stylized movements to popular and energetic music.

Pointe: Students practice classical ballet technique while supporting their weight on the tips of the toes wearing pointe shoes.

Tap: An upbeat class that incorporates rhythm, coordination and musicality through various combinations of intricate footwork.

DRESS CODE

Creative Movement: Any color bodysuit, light pink ballet tights, pink ballet slippers. Skirts or tutus are optional. Hair must be tied back.

Pre Dance: Any color bodysuit, light pink ballet tights, pink ballet slippers and black tap shoes. Skirts or tutus are optional. Hair must be tied back.

Acro: Solid color bodysuit, footless beige tights, a pair of socks, fitted shorts (optional), bare feet. Hair must be in a bun. Student must bring their own Yoga Block.

Ballet: Solid color bodysuit, light pink ballet tights, pink canvas split-sole ballet slippers with elastics. Ballet wrap skirt optional. Hair must be in a bun.

Broadway/Musical Theatre: Black tank top, black leggings or jazz shorts, beige tights if wearing shorts, beige slip on jazz shoes. Hair must be tied back.

Contemporary/Lyrical: Black tank top, black leggings or jazz shorts, beige tights if wearing shorts, bare feet. Hair must be in a bun.

Hip Hop: Exercise wear, tank top, t-shirt, sweat pants, and clean indoor, non-marking sneakers only. Outdoor street shoes are not permitted. Hair must be tied back.

Jazz: Black tank top, black leggings or jazz shorts, beige tights if wearing shorts, beige slip on jazz shoes. Hair must be in a bun.

Pointe: Solid color bodysuit, light pink ballet tights, pointe shoes with elastics and ribbons. Ballet wrap skirt optional. Hair must be worn in a bun. TheraBand and Yoga Block are required.

Tap: Black tank top, black leggings or jazz shorts, beige tights if wearing shorts, black lace-up tap oxfords. Hair must be in a bun.

Boys: T-shirt, shorts or sweatpants with appropriate footwear; black ballet slippers (Ballet), beige slip on jazz shoes (Broadway/Musical Theatre & Jazz), black lace-up tap oxfords (Tap), non-marking clean sneakers (Hip Hop).

*Please note that students may be required by their dance instructor to purchase TheraBand's, Yoga Blocks or other apparatuses which are used to aid in strength and flexibility training.

QUANTUM ELITE TEAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Competitive Dance Program at Quantum Dance Academy

The goal of the Elite Team at Quantum Dance Academy is to develop the full potential of our students by offering them a chance to compete in various dance festivals. When competing, dancers are adjudicated by judges who assess their performances and provide constructive feedback. This year, we will be attending [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] These competitions are ideal for students to further develop their technical abilities and stage presence.

Students will be selected by the Instructors and Directors for various numbers based on technical abilities, commitment, work ethic, attendance, attitude, and performance quality. Students may be asked to perform solos, duos, trios, small or large groups in different dance genres. Once your child has been asked to participate in extra numbers, the parents must accept or decline the invitation. For duos, trios, small groups and large groups, all students must accept to participate. If one or more students do not accept to participate in a duo, trio, small group or large group, the competition number may not be entered.

A total of 7.5 hours of rehearsals will be given to each number (divided and organized as the Instructor sees fit). Once the 7.5 hours have passed, students can receive additional rehearsals at a fee of \$25 per 30 minutes. This additional rehearsal fee is to be given to the Instructor at the extra rehearsal. Students are also expected to rehearse on their own. Studio time is available, please speak to a Director for more information on availability.

PRICES: The prices below go towards a costume*, music editing, choreography, rehearsals, and 3 festival entrance fees. Complimentary pictures are included with every competitive piece. Dancers in duos, trios, & groups will not take individual pictures for these pieces. Only the entire piece will have a picture taken. Selecting a Monthly Payment Plan requires a \$50.00 deposit per entry at time of registration, and payments are taken out on the 1st of every month starting in September and ending with the last payment on June 1st. Monthly Payment Plans require an additional \$2.85 administrative fee per month for this feature.

Elite Acceptance Deadline: Please enroll online or in-person during office hours before June 27th, 2019. Unfortunately, we will not be able to extend this deadline for any reason. We suggest registering at least a week before the deadline in case you have any technical difficulties. Deadline to register for the Quantum Elite Team is June 27th, 2019. If you missed auditions, please contact us by phone or email at info@quantumdance.ca.

Refunds: Once you have accepted and enrolled into the Elite Program, the total fees associated with each piece you have decided to register for are non-refundable for any reason. If you are paying monthly, these fees are still due each month until the total has been paid even if your student is no longer performing. If there are missed payments, late fees (see late fee policy for details) will accumulate until the total balance has been settled.

Dropping Classes: If a student drops a required class that will impede the training expected for a competitive member, a Director will terminate the student's involvement in that piece(s). Payment of all competitive fees are still due in full.

Solo Acceptance: In order for a student to be eligible to accept a solo, the student must accept any duos, trios, and groups before accepting any and all solos.

Scheduling: Students should be available for extra rehearsals any time during the regular dance season. Students will not be expected to be available during Christmas and Spring Break. Before accepting any pieces, please notify a Director if you plan to be away during the regular dance season.

Showcase: Students must be available for the Quantum Elite Team Showcase which will take place between January 15th & February 28th each season. This date will be confirmed before December 1st of that dance season.

Extra Events: Additional special events may arise that will be an opportunity for students to perform throughout the year.

Class Requirements: All Competitive Students are required to take a minimum number of hours. Students doing solos may be required to take additional classes (see below for required classes).
